Oolong Gallery, founded in Southern California in 2022 by Eric Laine, announces its expansion to Tribeca, New York, opening a solo presentation of painter Adam Rabinowitz GONGGONG May 15, 2026, marking a new chapter in the gallery's commitment to influential programming across both coasts. Established through a sequence of three distinct spaces in North County, San Diego, the gallery has steadily built a reputation for high caliber shows, collector engagement, and artist advocacy, culminating in six art fair presentations and thirty-five exhibitions thus far. A NADA member gallery now operating between San Diego and New York City, Oolong Gallery extends its exhibition programming into Lower Manhattan while maintaining its Rancho Santa Fe gallery by appointment over the summer. Recent and past presentations have included works by predominantly Southern California based artists such as Amy Adler, Nick Aguayo, Markus Bacher, My Barbarian, Claire Chambless, Josh Callaghan, Berlin's Marcel Eichner, Victoria Fu, Raul Guerrero, William Leavitt, Jasmine Little, Paulina Moncada, Minga Opazo, Fay Ray, Sally Scopa, and soon Houston's Jamie Sterling Pitt—reflecting a program attentive to intergenerational positions and strong artistic practices. Oolong Gallery continues to cultivate an audience of elite collectors, art institutions, and newcomers through exhibitions intended to elevate the trajectory of each artist concurrent with the growth of the gallery.
